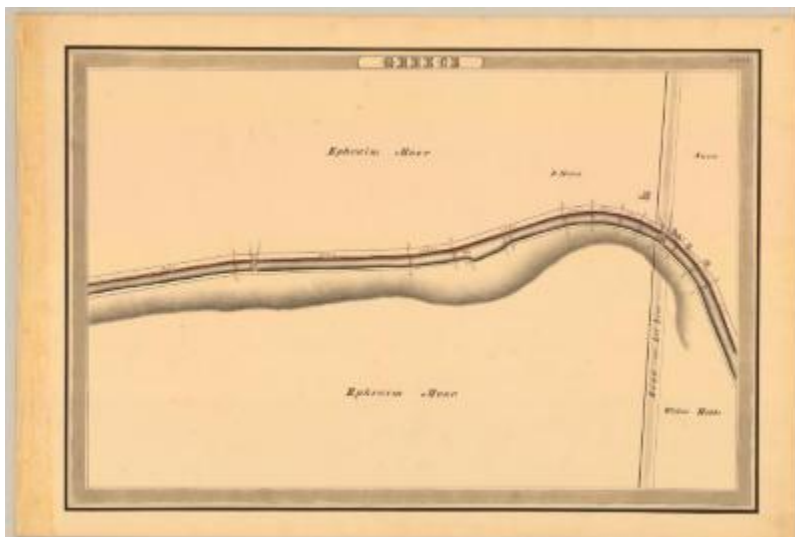


Erie Canal Survey, Greece showing Moor and Hobbs
