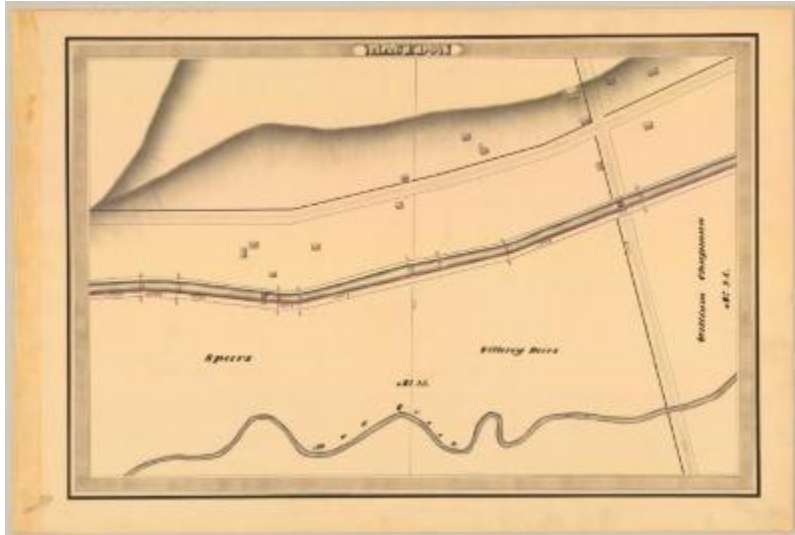


Erie Canal Survey, Macedon showing Speers and Chapman
