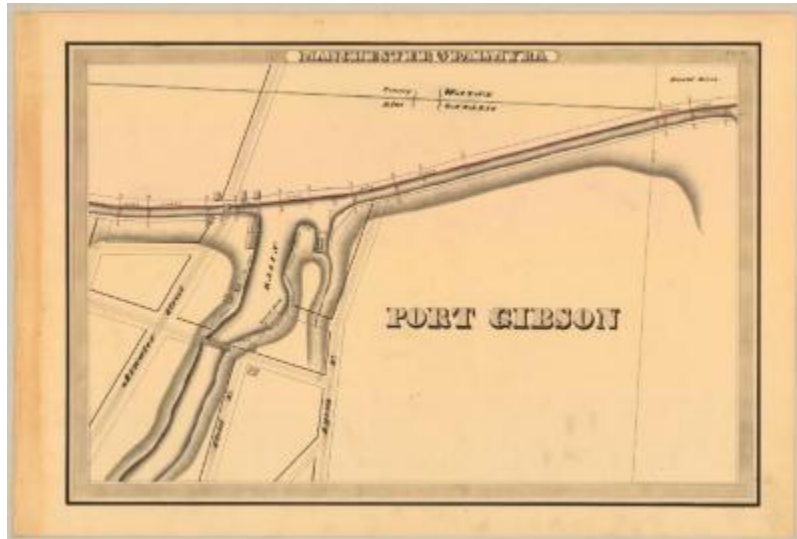


Erie Canal Survey, Manchester and Palmyra showing Port Gibson
