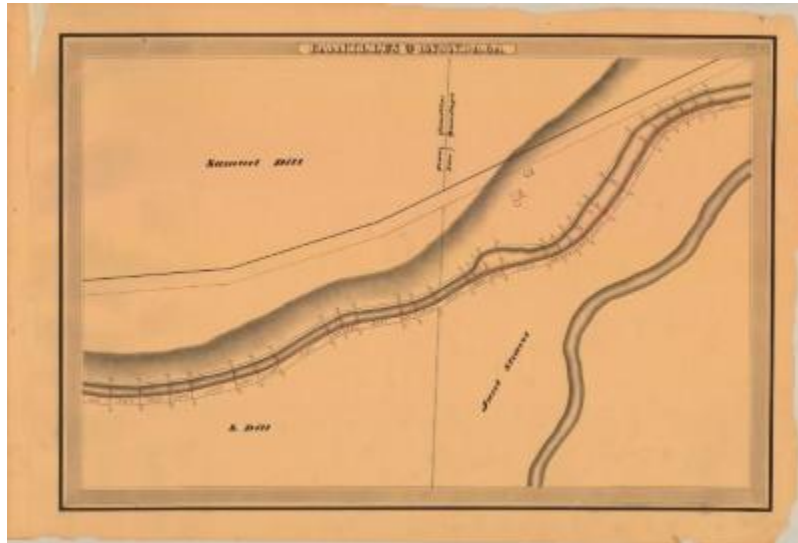


Erie Canal Survey, Camillus and Onondaga showing Town Line and Steaves
