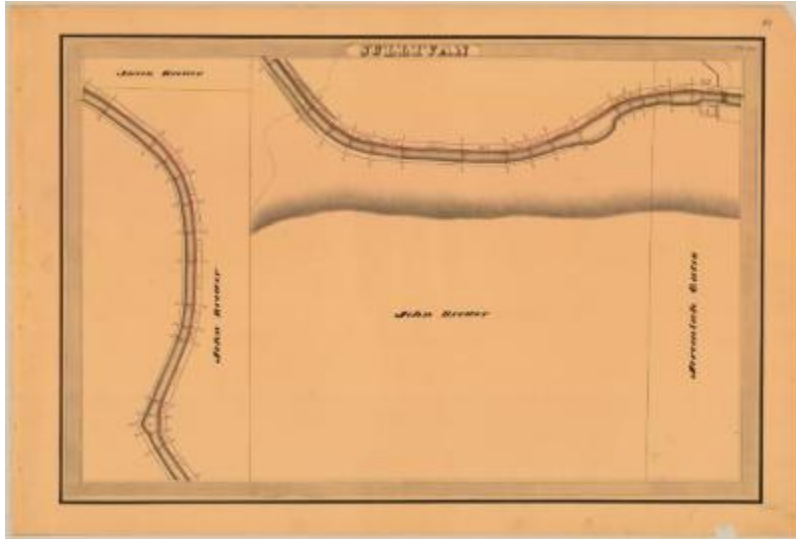


Erie Canal Survey, Sullivan showing Brower and Gates
