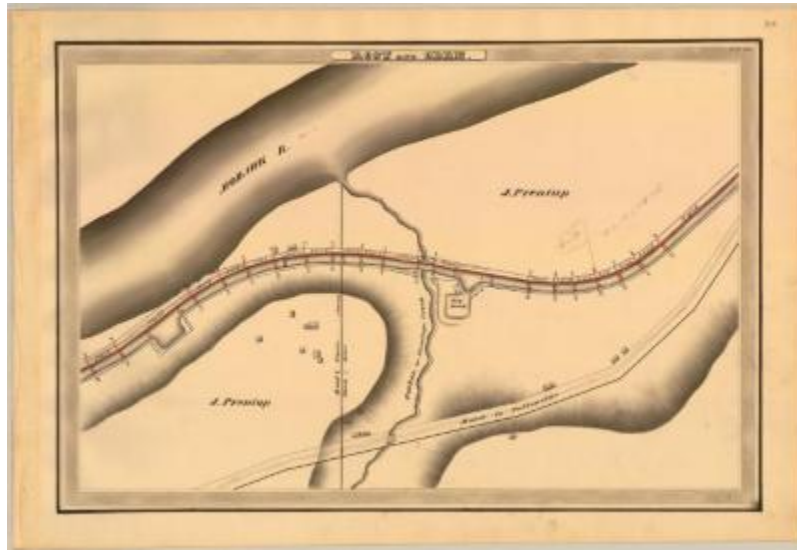


Erie Canal Survey, Root and Glen showing Town Line, Prentup's Creek and Dry Dock
