

Stocking a Stream with Hatchery Raised Fish



View of two men and a boy of about twelve releasing young fish ("fingerlings"), presumably hatchery-raised, into a stream. A boy of about six stands on the bank behind them, watching. Both the location and the date are unknown, but it is probably ca. 1918-1920. This image was created to record the game fish planting activities of the New York State Conservation Commission.
