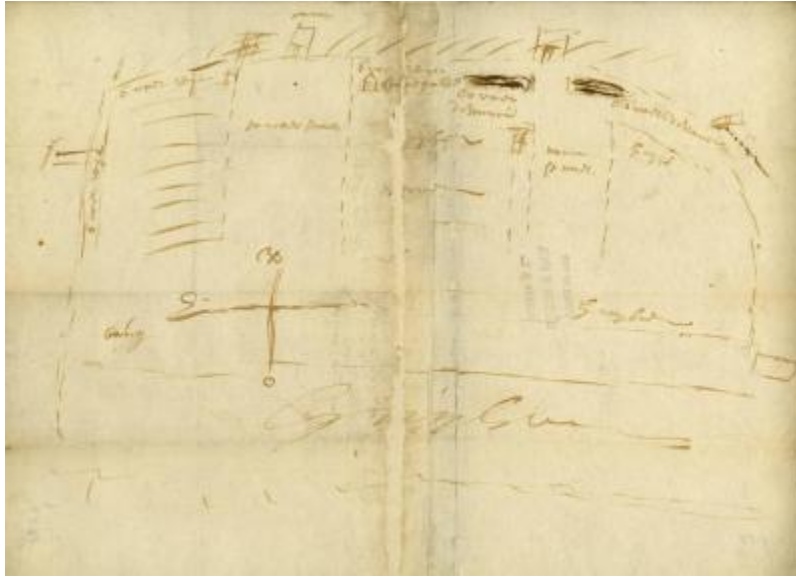


## Undated manuscript sketch of Beverwyck now the City of Albany
