

## Wiscoy Creek, Stream Improvement



View of a sign designating Wiscoy Creek as a public-access trout stream in either Eagle or Pike, Wyoming County, or Hume, Allegany County, N.Y. undergoing "stream improvement," possibly ecological restoration. The date is unrecorded, but probably 1936. Wiscoy Creek is a tributary of the Genesee River. The image is reversed. This image was created to record the stream improvement activities of the New York State Conservation Department.
