Amsterdam. Letter. Directors to Stuyvesant ; return of the latter ; boundary ; treaty at Hartford not received ; insincerity of the English ; no more colonies or patroons to be established in New Netherland ; Van der Capelle ; Melyn ; Dincklage ; trade between Boston and the Delaware ; members of the council not to assume the title of "High Councillors ;" letter box ordered to be set up in New Amsterdam ; emigrants.
