Amsterdam. Letter. Directors to Stuyvesant ; currency ; Protector of England writes to the people of Long island ; free passages to New Netherland ; treaty of Hartford ; Indians ; Lutheran minister and some bad women sent back to Holland ; cause of the separation of the Lutherans from the Dutch church ; coal and iron sent to New Netherland ; Latin school ; rev. Drisius ; rev. Gideon Schaets ; smuggling at Sandy hook ; emigration ; Wisbuysche Zee reghten. [1658]
