
# N.Y.S.F.I.C. Form 2: Individual Earnings, Establishment 104, Employee's No. 116, Paul Corinusky



The Factory Investigating Commission's Individual Earnings data card for Paul Corinusky [sic], a sugar pulverizer at Knickerbocker Chocolate, a candy factory in New York City. The card lists the establishment number; the employee number; the employee's name, address, occupation, age, and gender; and the employee's rate of pay, days and hours worked, and earnings for the payroll period from September 11 to September 18, 1913. During this week, Mr. Corinusky earned \$18.63 for 86 hours of work.
