
National Guard Muster Roll Abstracts for World War I, Volume 41, Section T: Jacob Tinson-Joseph Treadwell



This document contains the records of Jacob Tinson, Paul Titus, William Odus Tolbert, Robert Toler, Hartwell Tompkins, Henry Toomer, Jenario Torres, Charles Tossit, Earl Towns, Henry Towns, Charles Townsend, James Townsend, William Townsend, Archie Trautman, and Joseph Treadwell.;The individual abstracts for each enlisted man provide the following data: U.S. Army serial number; date and place of commission or enlistment; date of appearance for duty; dates of muster into service (N.Y. and U.S. with rank, company, and regiment); date and rank at time of leaving service; and reason for leaving service - type of discharge or transfer.;Following these data are "remarks" which sometimes give additional details. The lower part of the form has space to record personal information, however, this space is often left blank. Manuscript (handwritten) data on printed form.
