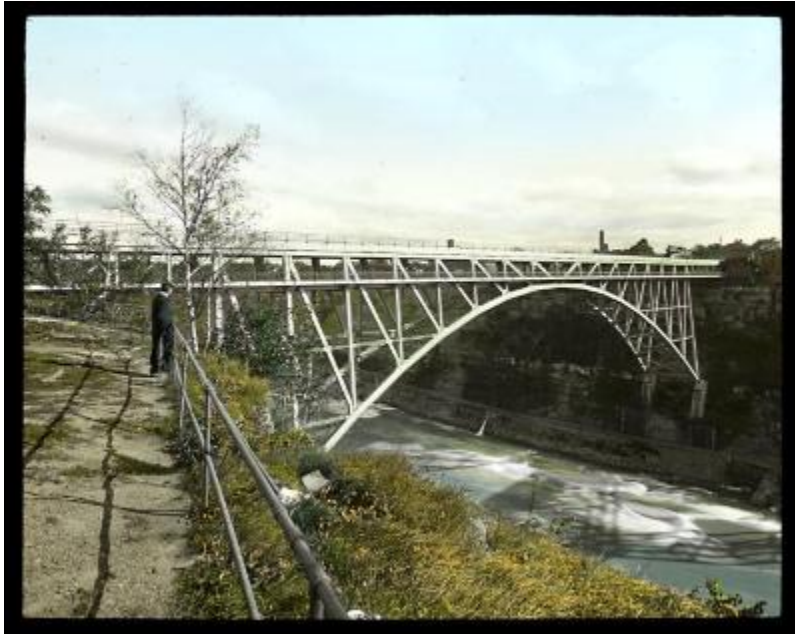


The Grand Trunk Railroad Bridge from the Canadian side. Niagara Falls
