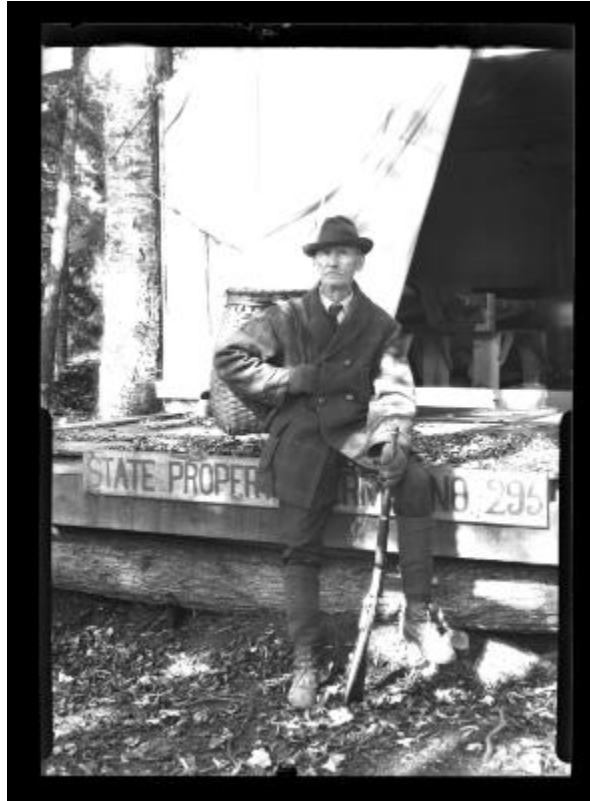


Anselm Parsons, Adirondack Guide
