Patent. Leendert Aerden (or Arentsen); 39 morgens of land comprehending Bylevelt's bouwery, situate in the rear of Corlear's plantation, adjoining the wagon road and Sellout's bouwery, Manhattan Island; patentee to pay the tenth of the crops as rent.
