

Patent of Gerrit Jansz for land on Manhattan Island



Patent. Gerrit Jansz from Oldenborch; 45 1/2 morgens 5 rods land formerly called the Pannebacker's bouwery, or bouwery No. 5, extending along the wagon road to Hans Kierstede's plantation, thence right through the woods up to the three corners of the inner wagon road, Manhattan Island.
