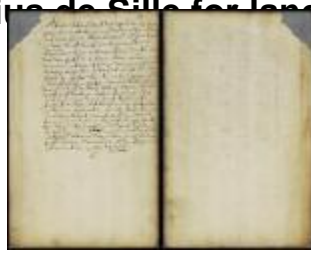


Patent of Nicasius de Sille for land on Long Island
