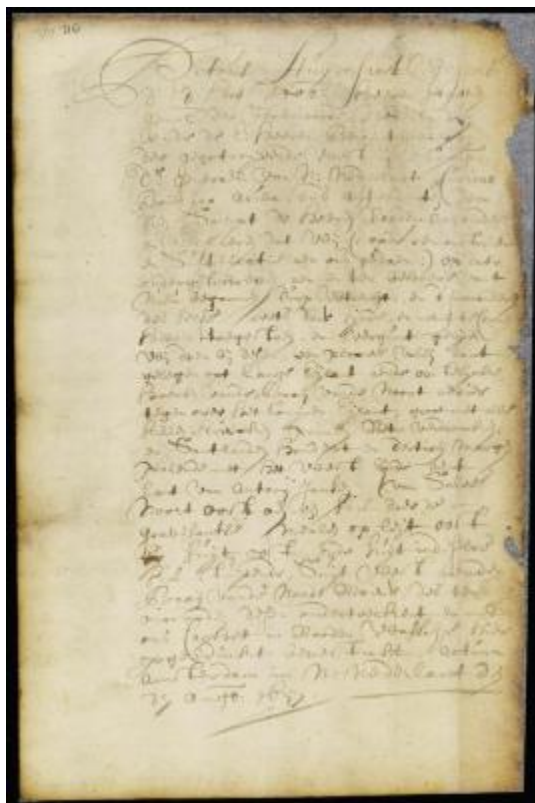


Patent of the inhabitants of New Utrecht for 130 morgens of land on Long Island
