Actions. Abraham Abrahamsen agst. Harmen Bastiaensen; plaintiff was hired to drive cart, but defendant requires him to do general work, to which plaintiff objects; judgment for defendant. Surgeon de Hince agst. Thomas Powelsen, for fees; defendant answers that plaintiff was engaged to attend the family for 2 beavers a year; plaintiff insists that such agreement referred only to sickness from natural causes, not to cases of wounds willfully inflicted; case put over. Actions of debt.
