Letter. Directors to Stuyvesant; unsettled state of affairs between Holland and England; books and records of the city's colonie on the Delaware, relative to Alrich's administration, to be transferred to the authorities there; case of a child being retained in New Netherland by a creditor, as security for a debt due by the mother; ordered to be released and sent to Holland.
