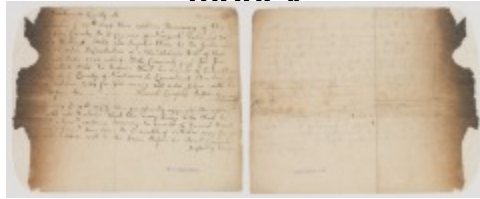


Depositions of William Browning and Elnathan Smith relating to counterfeit money
