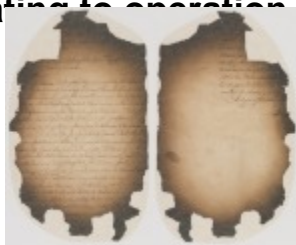


Petition of Abraham Kip relating to operation of a ferry across the Hudson
