

Demolition of old building by CCC workers, Centerville, N.Y.



An old building, most likely a barn, is being demolished by the Civilian Conservation Corps to make way for reforestation. The State Forest Service would purchase tracts of abandoned farmland like this one and allow the CCC to clean and reforest the area. This group is from CCC camp S-126, located in Centerville from 1935-1941. This image was created to record the reforestation work of the Civilian Conservation Corps under the supervision of the New York State Conservation Department.
