A White Pines (*Pinus strobus*) stands at the center of this image, 18" DBH (Diameter Breast Height). White Pines were favored by the Civilian Conservation Corps for their fast growth and their ability to shade slower growing hardwoods. A map is laid out on a log in the lower right corner. This image was created to record the reforestation work of the Civilian Conservation Corps under the supervision of the New York State Conservation Department.
