

Old waterhole, Schuyler County



This simple waterhole was dug in 1931 and is not up to the standards on the 1936 Civilian Conservation Corps. Waterholes held spring water for use during firefighting in the state forests. This image was created to record the reforestation work of the Civilian Conservation Corps under the supervision of the New York State Conservation Department.
