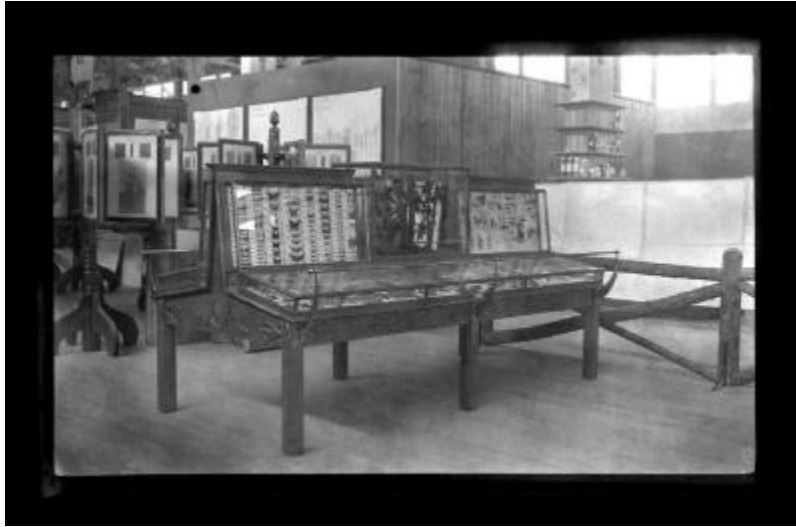


## Louisiana Purchase Exposition
