Dear Mr. Berens:

As discussed by telephone, we are in receipt now from attorney Elizabeth Fink of a list of 191 plaintiffs with a description of their injuries and how they claim those injuries were sustained. I enclose a copy of such list for your purposes, along with a copy of the transmittal letter of Elizabeth Fink dated 9/29/73 and addressed to Judge Elfin.

Also enclosed is a copy of a proposed order Mr. Fink submitted to Judge Elfin as her suggested substitute for the prior order of Judge Elfin which dictated dismissal of the claim of any plaintiff whose name and injuries were not submitted to the Court by the end of September, 1973. The proposed order suggests that a final notice be given to the class with a final date after which any claimant who does not respond, would be foreclosed. Hopefully, Judge Elfin will follow that format and such will place a settling on the residual claimants.
