1. I am an attorney-at-law duly licensed to practice in this Court, and I am a member of the law firm of Jackle Fleischmann & Neigel, LLP, attorneys for defendant Earl Pfeil. I make this affirmation in further support of defendant Pfeil's motions for judgments notwithstanding the verdicts, or alternatively for new trials, relating to each of the Smith and Brosig damages trials.

A number of inmates incarcerated at the Attica State Correctional Facility and present in the D Yard at the time of the retaking thereof of September 13, 1971 thereafter commenced actions against the State of New York in the New York Court of Claims.
