JOHN R. STEWART, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I am trial counsel to the firm of Gubin, Gubin and McBride, Esqs., attorneys for defendant, John Monahan and make this affirmation to a motion by Elizabeth Fink, Esq., attorney for plaintiffs class for a motion pursuant to Rules 14 and 26 of the FRCP for a definite scheduling order and a protective order to prevent the defendants from litigating for the purpose of delay and attrition.
