Defendant VINCENT R. MANCUSI, pursuant to the Court's Order of August 2, 1985, moves for an Order extending the time in which to examine the "main room" Attica documents an additional 120 days from the date of the Court's Order on this motion.

The grounds in support of this motion are:

1. Lack of access to the documents when the office opens late, closes early or is closed all day because Mr. Bob Mory, the custodian of documents, is absent from the office.
