Rockefeller was during his lifetime a member in the New York State Police and the action was commenced against him in his official and individual capacity and other New York State officials based upon their roles in the quelling of the 1971 Attica prison riot. This case was tried against four defendants in a four week trial, resulting in a hung jury against Defendant Monahan, Motion for Clarification was made after trial and was denied. <b>Issues:</b> 1. Whether the Appellant's conviction and sentence are constitutionally infirm.			
<b>Request:</b> Reversal and remission of sentence.
