JOSHUA L. EFFRON, an attorney at law duly licensed to practice
in the State of New York and before the United States District
Court for the Western District of New York does hereby affirm under
the penalties of perjury:

1. I am trial counsel to Gurde, Gurde, Lynch & Smith, the
attorneys of record for the Estate of John W. Murahan, one of the
defendants herein. I am fully familiar with the facts and
circumstances herein involved and I make this affirmation in
vigorous opposition to plaintiffs' request for a 30-day adjournment
of all litigation.

2. Paragraph 4 of the Deutch affirmation accompanying
plaintiffs' Motion makes reference to a refusal on the part of
defense counsel to agree to a adjournment. For the record, we
request for any adjournment was received by my office, and upon
information and belief, none was transmitted to the Gurde office.
Since a scheduling order had been established by Judge Elvin, it
would appear inconsistent with proper procedure that any request for
any change should have been addressed to Judge Elvin initially.
