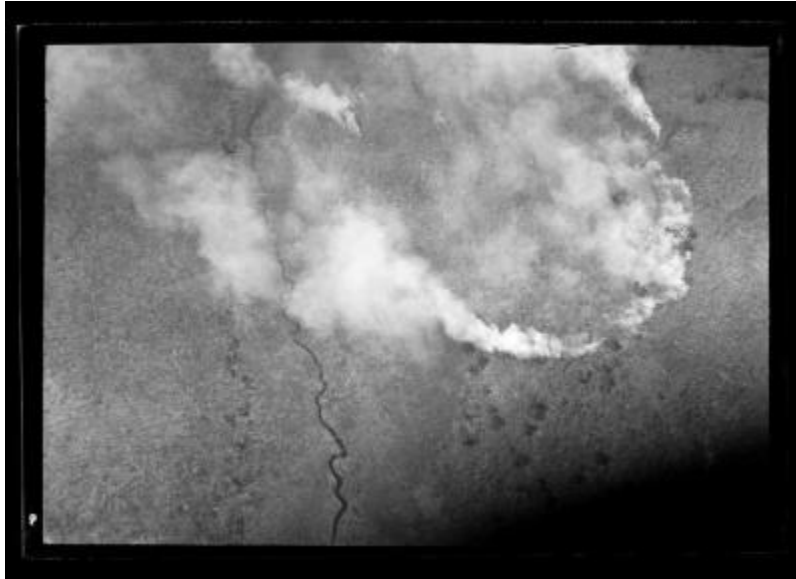


Forest Fire
