NOTICE

Plaintiff JEROME ROSENBERG respectfully asks this Court:

1. Plaintiff is a party to this action because of his presence in B-Yard at Attica Correctional Facility in Attica, New York, from September 9-13, 1971.
2. Plaintiff has practiced law since 1967 in the Courts of New York State and in United States District Court for the Western, Eastern, Southern, and Southern Districts of New York. He holds a Bachelor of Law Degree, Juris Doctor, from BLACKSTONE SCHOOL OF LAW, and has received offers to teach law at colleges in California and Texas, should he ever be permitted to re-locate there. He has handled over 270 civil and criminal cases as counsel at record, and has won 166 of them. He is a member of the AMERICAN TRIAL LAWYERS' ASSOCIATION and the NATIONAL LAWYERS' GUILD, and in 1964 was honored by the UNITED STATES JUDICIAL CHAMBER OF COMMERCE for his contribution to the welfare of the city.
