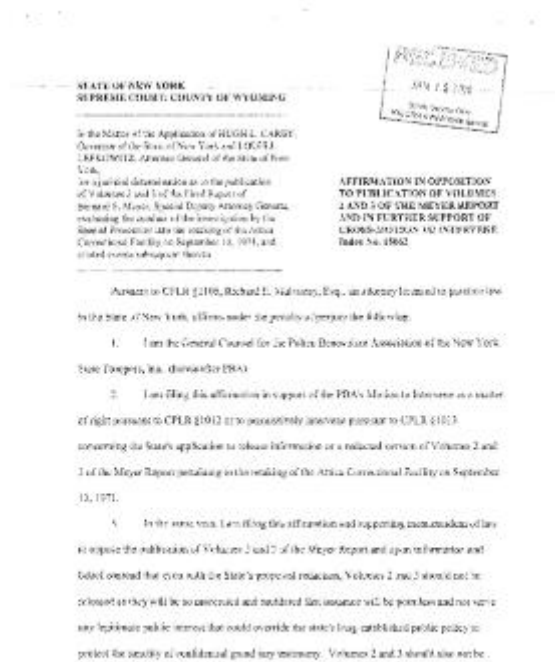

Carey, Governor of the State of New York and Louis J. Lefkowitz, Attorney General of the State of New York, for a judicial determination as to the publication of Volumes 2 and 3 of the Final Report of Bernard S.
