Though in certain places, especially out of sight in jail, inmates are constantly subjected to a number of things. One way some officials consider a proper way of reducing security and control is their using the "policy" of sweeps. This entails subjecting an inmate, commonly, to search every facility just a set out or a strip look or bathroom. Many the kind of a search tactic may work but the extent many set up is is definitely unsafe for and illegal.  
I myself have not only been treated by this with some to report it to - in Attica, Nevada, and because correctional facilities, but I have witnessed much else.
