I feel that the late Governor Rockefeller was elected by the people of the State of New York. Therefore it is time that the now sealed records of the 1971 Attica Prison riot be opened to the people who have been waiting 42 years to hear and read the rest of the story.

I am 80 years old man and was brought up in the Township of Alabama in Genesee County not too many miles from Attica.

My wife and I have driven by Attica Prison a number of times, a very foreboding place, quite more so after the 1971 riots.

To be listening to the news on that terrible day and hear the radio announcer describing the scene and then the pushing of the state troopers on the wall firing down on that fish pond of human beings flat on the ground not able to move or get out of the line of fire.

Also distressing the Monroe County coroner's report of who they were killed by.

Your Honor there are all too many things today that are done behind closed doors and with the stroke of a pen sealed up.

Please your Honor order all of the records of that 1971 Attica prison riot unsealed and open to those people who have waited forty-two years already to hear what actually happened to these loved ones, friends and neighbors.
