THOMAS LOUK, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I am the plaintiff in the above-captioned action and a normally healthy man with no serious past or present illness.
2. I was in custody at the Attica Correctional Facility (Attica) during the Attica uprising, which took place from September 9, 1971 to September 13, 1971.
3. On and prior to September 9, 1971, my cell was located in a block.
4. After the Attica uprising, my cell was located in a block of a right wing and that my right eye seemed to be covered by a glass eye.
5. At the time of the uprising, I was locked in my cell.
6. I was released from my cell by other inmates and was ordered, under threat of bodily harm, to proceed to a yard where I stayed for the duration of the uprising.
7. On September 13, 1971, immediately after the ending of Attica by the New York State Police and New York State Correctional Officers, I was taken approximately 150 feet away from the inmates.
