- I am an attorney at law and a member of the law firm of Urzacki, Calabrese & Magel, LLP, attorneys for defendant-appellant Karl Pfeil. This declaration is based on the knowledge I have obtained in my capacity as Pfeil's counsel.
- I make this declaration in response to plaintiffs-appellees' May 19, 1998 motion (received by me today) for permission "to file a final Brief on Appeal that refers directly to the documents and transcripts in the Record, in lieu of filing a 'Page Proof' Brief with such references first, followed by a 'Final' Brief with references to the Joint Appendix", and ¶ 1 of the affirmation of Elizabeth M. Pisk (the "First Affirmation").
- Specifically, plaintiffs-appellees complain that "Appellant Pfeil did not file an Appendix when he filed his brief, and in fact, the Appendix has not yet been completed, let alone printed or filed". The Affirmation, ¶ 3. This complaint comes as a complete surprise to me given that the parties have
