JOHN C. BAKER, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I reside at 45 Field Boulevard, Troy, New York 12180.
2. I am retired from the New York State National Guard effective January, 1976.
3. On September 13, 1971, I held the rank of Major General and I was the Chief of Staff to the Governor and Commanding General of the New York Army National Guard.
4. During the Attica riot, rebellion and insurrection, I was called by ailes to Governor Rockefeller to proceed to Attica, New York, to aid State authorities during that crisis.
