The parties, by their attorneys, and the State of New York, through the Attorney General, hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

Whereas, in an Order granted by this Court, a class action was certified under Rule 23(b)(1) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure determining that the plaintiff class shall consist of all (approximately 1200) inmates who were present in T-7 and of Attica Correctional Facility on September 13, 1971;

Whereas, in a Decision and Order of the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit, decided August 3, 1999, judgments in favor of two named plaintiffs, Frank Smith and David Rindig, were reversed, and the entire case was remanded to the Western District of New York for further proceedings in accordance with that Decision;

Whereas, at the direction of the Court, discussions have since taken place to determine whether or not the case can be resolved by way of settlement;

Whereas, there is an agreement to compromise the disputed claims, which agreement is intended to bring a conclusion to litigation pending in this case;
