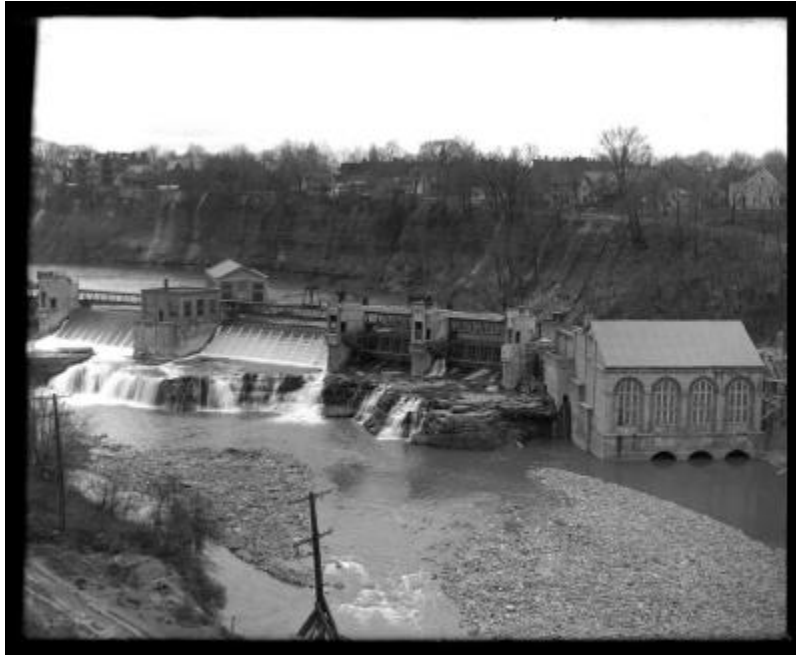


## Genesee River at Rochester
