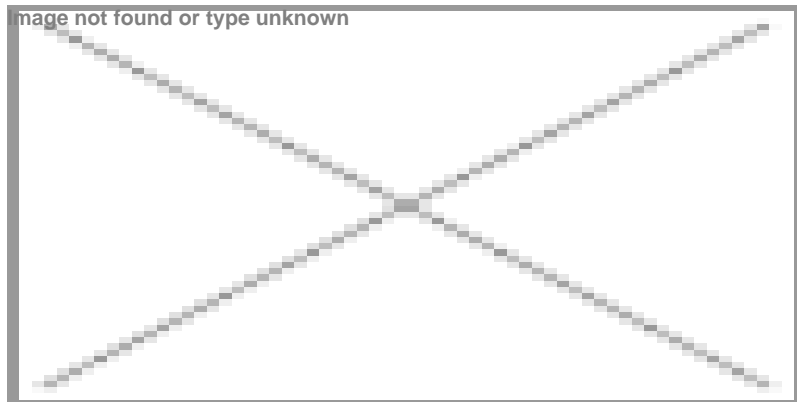


Side 1: Gabe Pressman with Governor Hugh Carey on Attica, 4/10/1975; Side 2: Carey-Samuels, 7/1/1974
