


**Audio Tape: A.M. No. 2 - Arthur O. Eve (part 2); P.M. No. 1 - Lynn Johnson

New York City Hearings – April 21, 1972 (Morning). Recording continues Arthur Liman’s examination of Assemblyman Arthur Eve. Eve discusses establishing credibility with the inmates and events leading up to and following the retaking. Commission members Wilbanks, Broderick, Wadsworth, and Henix ask follow-up questions on amnesty, Eve’s role as Observer, inmate demands, and Eve’s opinions on the press and the Commission. Robert McKay responds to Eve’s remarks on the McKay Commission. Eve gives a final statement. WRVR radio reporter and host give an overview of the morning’s proceedings. WRVR radio reporter, Dan Knox interviews McKay on Governor Rockefeller testifying.
