View of the Wasserfall, a waterfall on the Gutach River near Triberg in Baden-Wurttemberg, Germany. Spruce trees are scattered throughout the area near the waterfall. There are two bridges over the waterfall at separate points, revealing the presence of trails in the spruce forest. This image was probably created to record the landscapes-related activities of the New York State Forest, Fish, and Game Commission.
