View of reforestation area at Reynoldston in the Adirondack Mountains. Reforestation was undertaken around remains of an old planing mill boiler and dam (visible). In 1929 the State Reforestation Law was passed which led to increased reforestation activities, which after 1933 were often carried out by the Civilian Conservation Corps. Photograph has some discoloration.
