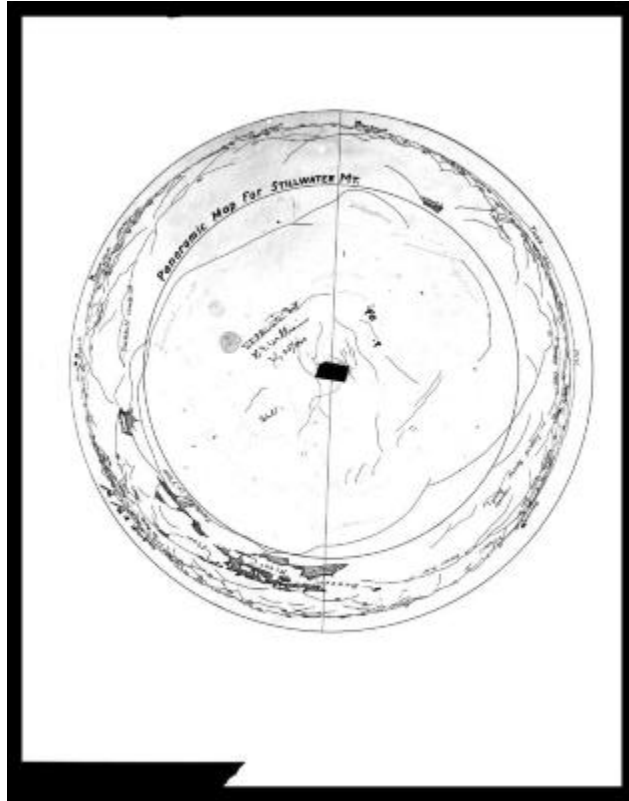


## Panoramic map for Stillwater Mountain
