To Governor Carey's right is President of the Seneca Indian Nation Robert C. Hoag. To Governor Carey's left is the Assistant Commissioner of the Department of Transportation William Hennessey. Also in attendance at the meeting were Barry Parker, Wayne Abrams, Maurice John, and Arthur Lazarus.
